

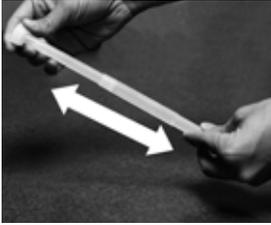

Two Birds Decor Top Installation



To install the Two Birds Finial you will need to use the clear extension tube included with your Bernini™ Fountain.

Before installing the extension tube, **pull the two ends of the extension tube apart to about 9 inches (22.8cm).**



Step 1: Remove the silicone cap from the top of the extension tube.



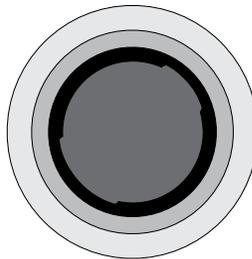
Step 2: Attach the extension tube to the water outlet in the middle of the fountain tier. NOTE: Extension must be included.



Step 3: Put the Two Birds Finial over the top of the extension tube. Be careful to keep the tube centered in the hole at the top of the Two Birds Finial.



Step 4: The Two Birds Finial locks into place using a key system in the middle of the fountain tier. (See illustration to the right) Align the bottom of the finial to the top of the fountain tier and twist the Two Birds Finial a quarter turn clockwise to lock it into place.

Note: You will notice that there are two different sized tabs on the bottom of the Two Birds Finial and there are two corresponding grooves in the top of the Fountain Tier. These tabs fit together and lock when turned clockwise.

Step 5: Replace the silicone cap on to the extension tube.



Step 6: Press the extension tube down until it is level with the top of the bowl of the Two Birds Finial.



Step 6: Align the pegs on the bottom of the two birds to the small holes on the rim of the bowl and insert to attach the birds.



At this point, your fountain should look like the image on the left. You are now finished installing the Two Birds Finial. Turn on your fountain and enjoy!
